

Annex 1: definition of the criteria used to assess the CBS implemented	
Acceptability	Perceived impression that CBS has been accepted and integrated by the community
Adaptability	Ability of the surveillance system to detect the emergence of a previously unknown pathogen/disease
Perceived usefulness	Perceived impression by stakeholders of having had a significant impact on the detection and management of epidemics
Responsiveness	Proportion of alerts investigated by the supervisor or a health centre manager less than 24 hours after detection
Sensitivity	Number of alerts validated by a healthcare professional, as a proportion of the total number of alerts received
Simplicity	Ease felt by stakeholders in understanding, executing, and implementing CBS
Sustainability	Willingness and ability of stakeholders to pursue the CBS beyond the project phase
